What we aim to achieve:

We will record and share our learning about our local heritage in paper-copy and digital formats, provide learning events e.g. talks and exhibitions, and conserve our Parish Hall for future generations to use and benefit from.

Here are some of the activities the group is working on:

Research

We are researching different aspects of our heritage and recording what we learn. We are researching the development of the local community and environment through investigations into dwellings, the local social and economic evolution, the relationship between the barn and the community / environment, the construction techniques used in the barn the change of use of the barn to a Parish Hall, local stories of interest, and information about other local community features e.g. the village water pump, local churches, local school, etc.

Learning

Learning as we research, and sharing our learning with others is an important part of our project. Members of our Heritage Group are working with children at East Worlington Primary School to research the local area and create a tapestry map to show their learning. We will produce a Heritage information booklet, a village / parish trail, a website, displays and exhibitions, provide talks and information sessions, and run workshops.
