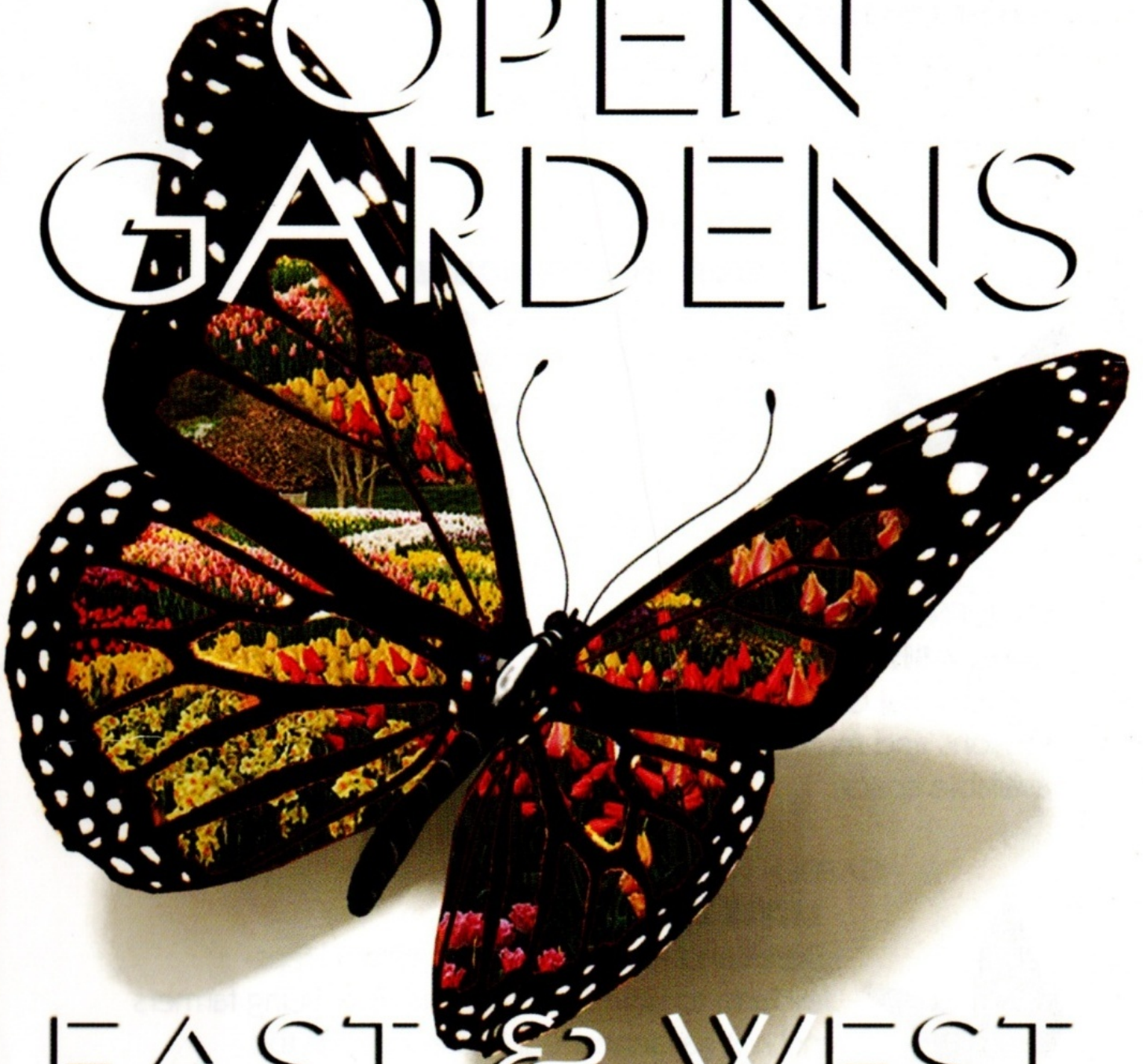

GARDEN No.6

KNIGHTS COTTAGE

The garden of Knights Cottage holds many delights.

The terraces offer a variety of seating areas from which you can take in the view of the surrounding area.

Special attention has been paid to encourage wildlife and over 70 different species of birds have been spotted since moving here nearly 3 years

ago. An abundance of floral displays are coupled with 6 raised veggie beds. Winding pathways lead you to secret areas and keep your eyes open for the 3 ladies.

GARDEN No.8

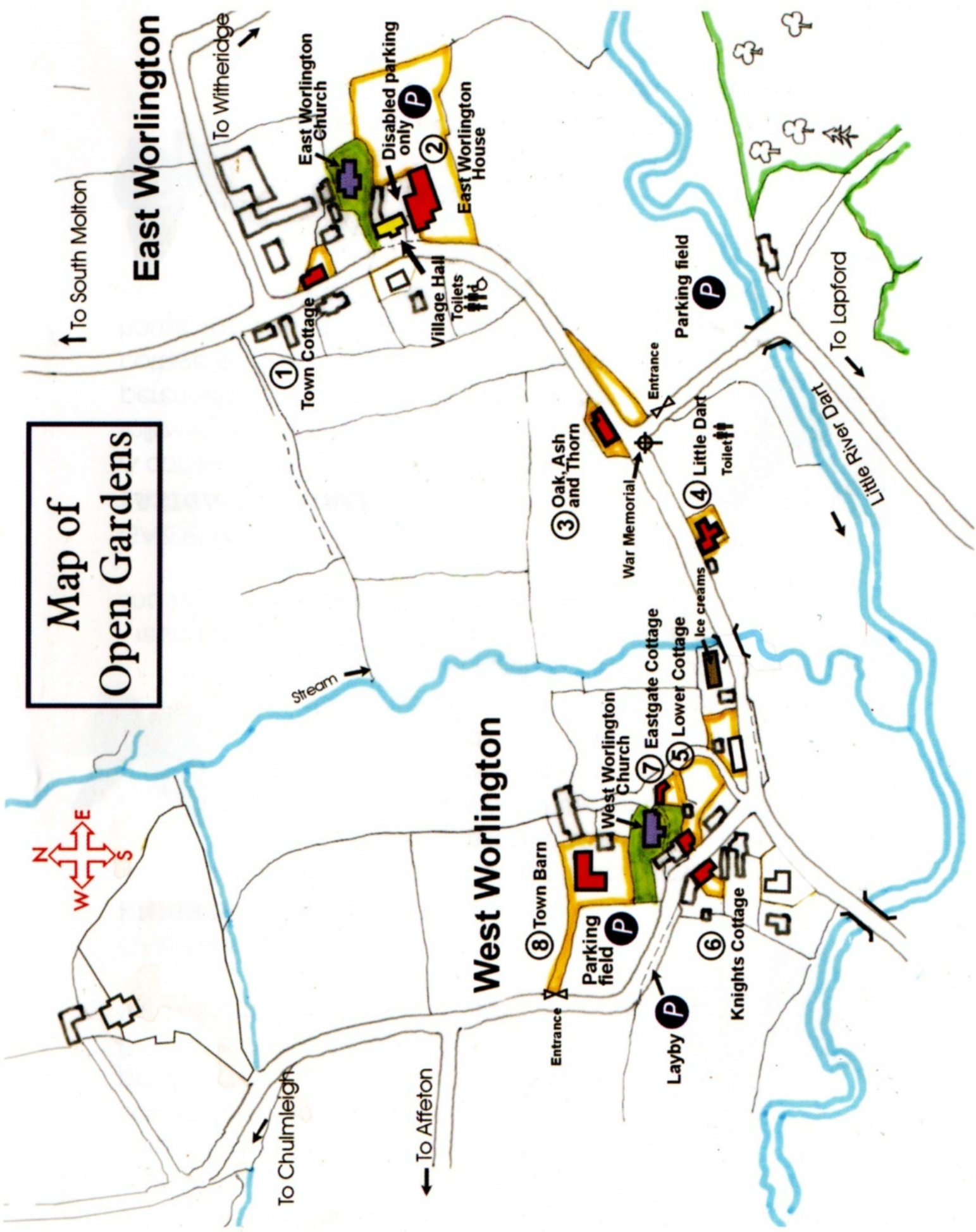
TOWN FARM BARN
