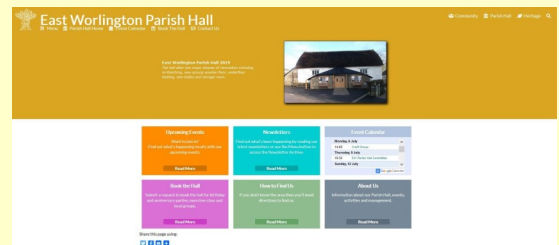
Due to Coronavirus our Parish Hall is closed

Opening the Hall Update

At the time of writing this article the Hall remains closed in line with national guidance. To prepare for reopening the Parish Hall Committee have to undertake a number of actions which include: following COVID-19 Secure Guidelines; securing social distancing; undertaking a risk assessment for COVID-19; ensuring appropriate cleaning; ensuring hiring arrangements include COVID-19 requirements; safeguarding volunteers and employees; following special arrangements for performances; having procedures if someone becomes unwell with COVID-19.

Planning for the Future

2020 starts a new decade and offers an opportunity and need to plan for the future. When COVID-19 allows more 'normal' living the Parish Hall Committee will start a consultation process with the community to help identify and clarify needs, ambitions, and ideas that help shape the strategic plan for the next 5 years and contribute to specific actions and activities. Over the last decade the Hall has developed its function as a Community Hub and a Heritage Learning Centre. Members of the Committee have taken lead roles in ensuring a Community Social Programme has been offered and heritage research, archiving and learning has strengthened the knowledge and evidence we have about our heritage. .
