- New cooker, dishwasher and boiler delivered
- New plaster sealed with first coat emulsion
- New external door delivered and fitted
- New aluminium guttering delivered and fitted

Kitchen Units, External Door, Electrics, Guttering



The new serving hatch has been constructed and fitted. There are two bi-folding doors which is a major improvement on the previous drop down arrangement. The doors will be painted to match the woodwork on the stage.



Mark has focussed on fitting the kitchen units this week. The units will provide much need storage space for kitchen equipment. The photograph shows the units that are located on the wall of the serving hatch.



The new cooker, dishwasher and water boiler have been delivered this week and work has been completed to enable them to be connected to the electric, water supply and drainage as necessary.



The external door to the kitchen has been fitted which provides a draught proof solution with emergency exit facility. This is a major improvement and supports our environmental policy and reduces our heating running costs.
