THIS WEEK'S ACHIEVEMENTS

This week has seen the progress to the completion of the refurbishment of the internal element of the kitchen project.

- Completed fitting of units
- Serving hatch completed and oak sill fitted
- Backboards fitted
- Plumber connects sink and connection for dishwasher
- Painter and decorator completed the decorations
- White goods installed
- Electrician completed the wiring, connection of appliances and provided certification
- Flag floor received final coat of sealer

Parish Hall Kitchen Refurbishment Project

Decoration, Fitting of Units, Electrical, Plumbing



At the start of the week the carcasses of the units were in place and ready for fixing of worktops and cupboard doors. The stone flags on the floor has received a first coat of sealer.



The external side of the kitchen door and oil tank door has been painted black to match the colour on the fascia boards and guttering. The inside of the kitchen door has been painted white to match the interior paint work.



Mark the joiner has fitted the backboards around the walls above the worktops. This solution will help maintain a clean environment and enable effective cleaning.



The fitting of units, backboards, sink and white goods was completed this week. The electrician has connected and tested the electrical circuits and white goods. The floor was sealed as the final job.
